# COVID-19 Relief Measures

## Government of Assam



---

### Ration Card Holders

#### **I Food Grains**

##### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- **Free rice** to be provided from April 1, 2020.

##### **Q. Who benefits?**

All ration card holding families.



---

### Non NFS Families

#### **I Cash benefit**

##### **Q. What is the benefit?**

Each family to receive ₹1000.

##### **Who benefits?**

- Poor families who don't have ration cards and not covered under the National Food Security Act.
- Panchayat representative or their family members not to be included in the list.



---

### Construction Workers

#### **I Cash Benefit**

##### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- Each family to receive ₹1000.

##### **Q. Who benefits?**

- Construction workers who are registered with the BoCW and engaged with embankment construction.



---

## Workers

### **I No termination of employment or salary reduction**

#### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- Employers **cannot fire workers or give them less salary** because of the lockdown.

#### **Q. Who benefits?**

- All workers including contractual and casual workers in the public or private sector.
- This order covers all establishments including Plantations, Factories, Industries, Malls, Shops etc.

## Farmers

### **I Early release of funds**

#### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- Government will provide **₹2500** for each family to buy farming equipment.

#### **Q. Who benefits?**

Farming families registered with the State.



---

## Adivasis

### **I Cash Benefit**

#### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- Each family to receive **₹1000**.

#### **Q. Who benefits?**

Those living in BTAD, Dima Hasao and Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council Areas.

## School Children

### **I Mid-Day Meal Schemes**

#### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- Government will deliver **mid-day meals** to students at their homes.

#### **Q. Who benefits?**

Children who are below 14 years of age and get Mid-Day Meals as part of the scheme.

**NOTE:** The Mid-Day Meal is offered in all schools run by Local Bodies, Government or aided by the Government including madrasas and maqtabas supported under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan.
