Ration Card Holders

I **Food Grains**

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Free rice** to be provided for the months of April and May 2020
- **Two months' quota of salt and sugar** to be distributed together in April 2020. Salt entitlements will be **free of cost** and sugar will be distributed at **₹17/kg**.
- If any fair price shop dealer is found violating these orders, **strict enquires** will be initiated against them under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and Chattisgarh Food Security Act, 2016.

Q. Who benefits?

Ration Card holders of Antyodaya, Priority, Disabled, Single Destitute and Annapurna category.



Student

I **Mid-Day Meal Scheme**

Q. What is the benefit?

- **40 days of ration** (dry dal and rice) will be provided to school-going children.
- This ration will be delivered to their homes on the **3rd and 4th of April**.
- Each student of a primary school will be provided with **6 kg of rice** and **1.2 kg of dal**.
- Each student of a middle school will be given **4 kg of rice** and **800 gms of dal**.

Q. Who benefits?

Primary and Middle school students who receive mid-day meals in their schools.

I **Dry Rations for children aged 3-6 years**

Q. What is the benefit?

Provision of **take-home dry rations** from **125 grams to 750 grams** for children between the ages of 3 and 6 years.

Q. Who benefits?

Children aged 3-6 years who are provided meals at anganwadis and mini anganwadis.



Destitute, Needy, Beggars

I Provision of cooked meals

Q. What is the benefit?

- Distribution of **food packets** to the needy with support from charitable groups, religious bodies and NGOs.
- This will be distributed **free of cost**.

Q. Who benefits?

Persons identified as needy, destitute, homeless, beggars etc. by the district administration, particularly in urban areas.



General

I Reduction in Electricity Bill

Q. What is the benefit?

- Electricity **meter reading / billing to be stopped** till March 31, 2020.
- **Half-rate** for electricity for two months under the "Half Rate Scheme".

Q. Who benefits?

All those with meter connections.
