Government of Delhi



Ration Card Holders

I Food Grains

Q. What is the benefit?

- **7.5kg free ration** for one month (April, 2020).

Q. Who benefits?

All Ration card holders.



Non Ration Card Holders

I Food Grains

Q. What is the benefit?

- Free ration (**5kg**) from fair-price shops in Delhi starting from the **second week of April**.
- People can **register** for this at this website - <https://ration.jantasamvad.org/ration/>
- After registration they will receive an **e-coupon** to take to the distribution centre.

Who benefits?

Non ration card holding poor families living in Delhi.

NOTE: To register, one needs to have **Aadhar card**, and a **family photo** as proof.



General

I Food Provision for the Needy

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Lunch and dinner served free** to every person at all Delhi government shelters (224 night shelters, 325 schools).

Q. Who benefits?

Residents of night shelters, the poor, homeless and migrants.



Private Sector Workers

I No salary reduction

Q. What is the benefit?

- All employees will be treated as being '**on duty**' during this lockdown period.
- They need to be paid their **full salaries**.

Q. Who benefits?

All private sector employees including temporary/contractual/outsourced workers.



Construction Workers

I Cash Benefit

Q. What is the benefit?

- Each unemployed construction worker will be given ₹5000.

Q. Who benefits?

Unemployed construction workers registered with the Construction Workers Welfare Board (CWFB) of the Delhi government.



Transport Service Providers

I Cash Benefit

Q. What is the benefit?

- Each person will be given ₹5000.

Q. Who benefits?

Transport service providers like drivers of Autos, E-Rickshaws, RTVs and Gramin Seva.



Pensioners, Divyang and Widows

I Increase in Pension

Q. What is the benefit?

- The Government has decided to **double the pension** for March.
- The pension for March and April to be given by **April 7**.

Q. Who will benefit?

All existing beneficiaries of the Divyang Pension, widow pension and age-old pension scheme.



Health Professionals

I Compensation

Q. What is the benefit?

- The state government would be giving ₹1 crore to the families of healthcare workers if these workers die while treating COVID-19 patients.

Q. Who benefits?

- Applicable to doctors, nurses, sanitation workers or any other staff, whether temporary or permanent who are serving and treating COVID-19 patients
- These health care professionals could be working either in the Public or Private sector.
