



COVID-19 Relief Measures

Government of Haryana



Ration Card Holders

I Food Entitlement

Q. What is the benefit?

- Monthly rations for April to be given **free of cost**.
- Pink and Yellow ration card holders are to be given **2 litres mustard oil, 1 kg sugar, 1 kg dal and 10 kg wheat** per member.
- Khakhi ration card holders are to be given **10 kg wheat** per member and **1 kg dal**.
- The ration will be distributed to the families by April 5, 2020.

Q. Who will benefit?

All Pink, Yellow and Khaki ration card holders.



Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) families

I Mukhyamantri Parivar Samridhhi Yojana

Q. What is the benefit?

- The government has started distributing ₹4000 (out of the annual allocation of ₹6000) per family.
- The balance of ₹2000 is to be distributed before March 31.
- A further amount of ₹6000 will be given to each of these families in April.

Q. Who will benefit?

Families registered under the MMPY.



Poor Families (not covered under any Government Scheme)

I Cash Transfer

Q. What is the benefit?

- Families would be provided financial assistance of ₹1000 per week.
- An SMS-based unique system has been evolved for the verification of such families

Q. Who will benefit?

- Poor families that are not covered under the categories of BPL, MMPSY and Construction Workers.
- Families with land-holdings of less than 5 acres and annual income less than ₹1.80 lakh and are not getting any financial assistance under any other category.



BPL families not registered under MMPY

I Cash Transfer

Q. What is the benefit?

- Each family shall be provided **₹4500 per month** (₹1000 per week) from March 30.
- This will be deposited directly into their bank accounts.

Q. Who will benefit?

BPL families not registered under MMPY.



Farmers

I Loan Repayment Relief

Q. What is the benefit?

- Farmers will get time until **June 30, 2020** instead of April 15 to **repay their crop loans**.
- Farmers will continue to get the benefit **interest subvention till June 30**.

Q. Who will benefit?

Farmers who have taken crop term crop loans from banks and have to repay by April 15.



Construction Workers

I Cash Transfer

Q. What is the benefit?

- Workers will be given **₹4500 per month**.
- This amount will be deposited on a **weekly basis** in instalments.
- This will be deposited directly into their bank accounts.

Q. Who will benefit?

Construction workers registered with the Haryana Building and Other Construction Worker's Welfare Board, but not registered with the MMPY.



Daily Wage Earners

I Cash Transfer

Q. What is the benefit?

- Direct cash assistance of **₹1000 per week**.
- Amount will be directly transferred to the bank accounts of the beneficiaries.

Q. Who will benefit?

- In order to be eligible, poor persons who were earning on a daily basis such as mazdoors, street vendors etc. may register with the Deputy Commissioner of the district on a portal that will be established by March 27.
- One needs to have a bank account to avail of this scheme.



Migrant Workers and Homeless

I **Relief Camps**

Q. What is the benefit?

- **467 relief camps** have been set up in the State with a capacity of **70,000 people**.
- These camps provide food and other necessities.

Q. Who will benefit?

Stranded migrant workers and the homeless.

I **Food Packets**

Q. What is the benefit?

- Beneficiaries to receive **packed rations**.

Q. Who will benefit?

The poor and migrants who do not have a ration card.



Students

I **Provision of Dry Ration**

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Dry rations** to be provided during the lockdown period for schools and anganwadis.

Q. Who will benefit?

All school children enrolled in Government Schools and all children in anganwadis.



Workers

I **Advisory against termination of employment**

Q. What is the benefit?

Employers are advised **not to dismiss** any employee for their absence during the lockdown period.

Q. Who will benefit?

All workers working in industries and commercial establishments.



Contractual Workers employed by the Government

I **No salary reduction**

Q. What is the benefit?

- Workers will continue to **receive their wages** during the lockdown period.

Q. Who will benefit?

All contractual workers with the Government



General

| Electricity and Water Bill surcharge relief

Q. What is the benefit?

- In case of delay in payment of electricity, water or sewerage bills by the due date, then **no surcharge or interest** shall be charged till **April 15**.

Q. Who will benefit?

Domestic, commercial or small industrial consumer



Transportation

| Penalty Relief

Q. What is the benefit?

- **No penalty** charged for delay in renewal.

Q. Who will benefit?

People whose vehicles are due for renewal/passing from March 15 to April 30, 2020.

| Tax Relief

Q. What is the benefit?

- **100% exemption from the Motor Vehicle Tax** for the period they are not allowed to ply because of the lockdown.

Q. Who will benefit?

Stage and Contract Carriage vehicle owners.



Health Professionals

| Accident Insurance

Q. What is the benefit?

- Health professionals will get a **compensatory amount** in case of death after being infected with COVID-19 while treating corona virus patients.
- Doctors will get **₹50 lakh**, nurses will get **₹30 lakh** and the associated staff will get a compensatory amount of **₹20 lakh**.

Q. Who will benefit?

- This insurance covers nurses, paramedics, technicians, doctors and specialists who work in both private and public hospitals.
- Applicable to those not covered under the newly introduced ₹50 lakh insurance cover of the Centre.
