Government of Odisha



Ration Card Holders

I Ration

Q. What is the benefit?

- Ration for a period of **three months** to be distributed between April 1 and May 15.
- **Home-delivery** of rations in urban areas.
- **Rice, wheat and subsidised kerosene oil** will be part of the rations distributed.

Q. Who is going to benefit?

Households receiving rations under the Public Distribution System (PDS).

Cash Benefit

Q. What is the benefit?

Each ration card holders will get ₹1000.

Q. Who benefits?

- Ration card holders covered under the National Food Security Act
- Ration card holders covered under the State Food Security Scheme (SFSS)



MGNREGA Workers

I Work

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Job cards** will be issued for workers willing to do unskilled work.
- Individual benefit projects to be taken up on priority.
- **Soap/hand-wash facilities** and **drinking water** will be available at worksites.

Q. Who is going to benefit?

Unskilled labourers and MGNREGA job card holders in rural Odisha.



General Public

I Cooked Meal

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Cooked meal** to be provided at Gram Panchayat and Municipal level

Q. Who will benefit?

Sick people as identified by the Gram Panchayat or Municipality/Nagar Panchayat



Registered Construction Workers

I Cash benefit

Q. What is the benefit?

A one-time payment of ₹1500.

Q. Who benefits?

All registered workers under Building and Other Construction Worker Welfare Board.



Migrant Workers

I Camps – Food, healthcare and shelter

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Food** will be provided in **250 camps** set up in the state.

Q. Who will benefit?

Unorganized workers from other states and regions who are staying back.



Registered Street Vendors

I Cash benefit

Q. What is the benefit?

- A one-time payment of ₹3000.

Q. Who benefits?

Street vendors who have registered themselves at an Urban Local Body.



Employees and Outsourced Workers of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)

I Timely payment of Salaries

Q. What is the benefit?

- Salary of ULB employees must be paid on or before April 1, 2020.
- Salary of out-sourced workers such as sanitation workers must be paid on time.

Q Who benefits?

ULB Employees and outsourced Workers



Children, and Pregnant and New Mothers

I Ration

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Take-home rations** and **rations for hot cooked meal** for the month of April to be delivered at door-step.
- **Eggs** will be distributed to households with children enrolled in Anganwadis.

Q. Who is going to benefit?

Pregnant and lactating mothers, and children (6 months to 3 years) covered under Supplementary Nutrition Program at Anganwadis.



Students

I Ration for Midday Meal

Q. What is the benefit?

- Class 1 to 5 students will receive dry ration of **3 kg rice per month**; Class 6-8 students will receive dry ration of **4.5 kg rice per month**.
- Rations will be supplied for a period of 3 months (till June 13).
- Rations can be collected from Ration Shops.

Q. Who is going to benefit?

Students of government and government aided schools belonging to class 1 to 8.



Pensioners

I **Advance Payment of Pensions**

Q. What is the benefit?

Advance payment of **pension amount for three months.**

Q. Who will benefit?

Beneficiaries of all social security pensions given out by Government Of Odisha



Sick, Indigent and Destitutes

I **Food Provision**

Q. What is the benefit?

- **Two meals per day** to be provided to all those in need
- The cost of these meals will be as following:
 - **₹60 per day** for each adult
 - **₹45 per day** for each child (upto 12 years old)

Q. Who will benefit?

All the poor, needy sick, indigent and destitute persons residing in the rural areas of the state.



Doctors, medical and paramedical staff

I **Advance Salary**

Q. What is the benefit?

- Salary for **4 months** to be transferred in advance.

Q. Who is going to benefit?

All government doctors, medical and paramedical staff.
