Government of Punjab



Workers

I No termination of employment or salary/wage reduction

Q. What is the benefit?

- Employers **cannot fire workers or give them less salary** because of the lockdown.

Q. Who benefits?

All workers including those in factories, industries, and all commercial establishments.



Daily-Wage Labourers and Unorganized Labourers

I Delivery of Dry Rations

Q. What is the benefit?

Packets of **10 kg of flour**, **2 kg of pulses** and **2 kg of sugar** distributed door-to-door.

Q. Who will benefit?

Daily-Wage Labourers and Unorganized Labourers.



Migrant Workers

I Food, work and shelter

Q. What is the benefit?

- Packets of **10 kg of flour**, **2 kg of pulses** and **2 kg of sugar** distributed door-to-door.
- School buildings to be opened for **accommodation**.
- Industries, brick kilns allowed to operate if migrants can be **accommodated safely and be provided food**.

Q. Who will benefit?

Unorganized workers from other states and regions who are staying back.



Registered Construction Workers

I Cash Transfer

Q. What is the benefit?

- A one-time payment of **₹3000**.

Q. Who benefits?

All registered workers under Building and Other Construction Worker Welfare Board



Students

| Ration for Midday Meal and Cooking Cost

Q. What is the benefit?

- Primary school students will receive **1.2 kgs of both rice and wheat** and ₹107.52 to cover the cooking cost.
- Upper primary school students will receive **1.8 kgs of both rice and wheat** and ₹161.04 per day to cover the cooking cost.
- The rations and amount transferred are for **24 days** i.e. from March 23 to April 15, 2020.
- Rations will be delivered in **sealed packets** to students at their homes.

Q. Who is going to benefit?

Students of government and government aided schools studying in primary and upper primary classes.



General Public

| Deferred payment of water and sewerage bills

Q. What is the benefit?

- Payment of water and sewerage bills can be **delayed by one month**.

Q. Who will benefit?

General public.



Property Owners

| Tax Cut

Q. What is the benefit?

- Property tax will be **exempted** till May 31, 2020.

Q. Who benefits?

Property-tax paying owners of property.



Police Personnel and Sanitation Workers

| Health Insurance

Q. What is the benefit?

- A health insurance amount of ₹50 lakh.
- This will be on the lines of the Central Government announcement for health workers

Q. Who benefits?

Police personnel and sanitation workers involved in the State's action plan to contain the virus outbreak.
