



# COVID-19 Relief Measures

## Government of Jharkhand



### Ration Card Holders

#### I Food Grains For Priority Households

##### Q. What is the benefit?

- For the month of **April**, PHH card holding families will receive **10kg grains** per family member at the rate of **Re.1 per kg**.
- For the month of **May**, PHH card holding families will receive **10kg grains** per family member **free of cost**.
- For the month of **June**, PHH card holding families will receive **5kg grains** per family member **free of cost** and the **other 5kg grains** per member at **Re.1 per kg**.

##### Q. Who benefits?

Families holding Priority Household ration cards.

#### I Food Grains For AAY

##### Q. What is the benefit?

- For the month of **April**, AAY card holding families will receive in total **70kg grains** at **Re.1 per kg**.
- For the month of **May**, AAY card holding families will receive **10kg grains** per family member **free of cost**.
- For the month of **June**, AAY card holding families will receive **35kg grains** per card at **Re.1 per kg** and **5kg grains** per member **free of cost**.

##### Q. Who benefits?

Families holding AAY (Antyodaya Anna Yojana) ration cards.



### Ration Card Applications are Pending

#### I Food Grains

##### Q. What is the benefit?

- The government will distribute **10kg of rice** per family at the rate of Re.1 per kg.

##### Q. Who benefits?

All families who fall under the coverage of the National Food Securities Act but whose applications are still pending with the Existing Ration Card Management System (ERCMS).

Identification of such families will be done by the district and block officials.

## Poor and vulnerable persons

### I **Dal-Bhat Kendras**

#### Q. What is the benefit?

- Opening up of community kitchens at the thana level in all districts of the State.
- The centres provide **cooked meals** to 200 persons each day.
- Each meal costs **Rs. 5** per person.
- These 'dal-bhat' kendras will be operational till **May, 2020**.

#### Q. Who benefits?

Migrants, homeless and disabled persons are the intended beneficiaries.

### I **Emergency Relief Packets**

#### Q. What is the benefit?

- In places where it is difficult to open community kitchens, dry rations will be provided to the poor.
- These rations will consist of **2kg chuda**, **½kg gur (jaggery)**, and **½kg chana**.
- 5000 of these emergency relief packets shall be distributed in Ranchi and 2000 in the remaining 23 districts of the state.

#### Q. Who benefits?

The needy and poor belonging to places where it is difficult to open community kitchens.

## Workers

### I **No salary reduction**

#### Q. What is the benefit?

- Employees during this lockdown period will be treated as being 'on duty'.
- They need to be paid their **full salaries**.
- If workers are not receiving full earnings, they can call the **helpline number: 18003456526**.

#### Q. Who benefits?

Employees working in shops, commercial establishments, factory, warehouses, offices, local weekly markets.

## Pensioners

### I **Cash Transfer**

#### Q. What is the benefit?

- **March** and **April's pension** has been released **in advance**.

#### Q. Who benefits?

All beneficiaries of existing pension schemes.

## Children

### **I Home delivery by Anganwadi Centre**

#### **Q. What is the benefit?**

- Home delivery of food to the houses of the children.

#### **Q. Who will benefit?**

Children who are provided meals at anganwadi centres.
