

Relief Measures announced by the Government of Punjab

General

Extension of due date

Q. What is the benefit?

- Due date of electricity bills payable on or after the 20th of March, have been granted an extension up to 20th April, 2020.
- Those paying their bills during this extension period will not have to pay a levy of late payment surcharge.
- Fixed charges of industrial consumers will also be exempted for two months, w.e.f. 23.3.2020, and energy charges may be fixed commensurate with reduction in fixed charges (single rate).

Q. Who benefits?

- Domestic and commercial consumers having current monthly/bi monthly bills upto Rs. 10000/- payable and Medium Supply (MS) and Large Supply (LS) Industrial Consumers.

Additional cash relief

Q. What is the benefit?

- Workers to get a second installment of Rs 3000 each after the first installment released on 22nd March.

Q. Who benefits?

- All registered workers under the Building and Other Construction Worker Welfare Board.
