

Relief Measures announced by the Government of Telangana

Agricultural Traders

Extension on License Renewal

Q. What is the benefit?

- Extension of time for renewal of trader licenses due on or before 31.3.2020 in the Agricultural Market Committees in the state.
- There will be no late fee charged.
- This extension is up to 30th June, 2020.

Q. Who benefits?

- Traders of agricultural goods who had to renew their licenses before the end of March.

School Children

No increase in fees

Q. What is the benefit?

- The state government has instructed that schools shall not increase any kind of fees during the academic year 2020-21 and shall charge only tuition fee on monthly basis till further orders.
- This instruction is applicable to all all private unaided recognized schools in the state, which are affiliated to State Board, CBSE, ICSE & other International Boards.

Q. Who benefits?

- School going children.

Those living in rented accommodation

Deferment of rent payment for three months

Q. What is the benefit?

- The state government has directed all property owners (whether of temporary, semi-permanent or permanent property) in the state to defer the collection of rent from their tenants for three months.
- This order comes into force from March, 2020.
- After a period of three months, the rent can be collected in installments.
- Whoever violates this, can be penalised as per the Epidemics Act, 1897 and Disaster Management Act, 2005.

Q. Who benefits?

- Tenants affected by the lockdown.
