

Relief Measures announced by the Government of West Bengal

Migrant Worker

Sneher Paras Scheme

Q. What is the benefit?

- Rs. 1000 will be given to migrant workers from West Bengal stranded in other states.
- Scheme is applicable from 20th April to 3rd May.

Q. Who benefits?

- Migrant workers from West Bengal stranded in other states.
- To be eligible, workers have to give their EPIC/Khadyasathi/Aadhar number to prove that they are residents of the State.
- Once filled in, the details need to be approved by the District Magistrate/Commissioner of KMC.
- To fill in details, one needs to download the West Bengal Sneher Paras app by visiting Google Play Store or clicking the Jai Bangla link provided in the home page of the Government of West Bengal.

Extension of Scheme

Q. What is the benefit?

- The insurance scheme announced earlier (see West Bengal relief measures flyer) has been extended upto 31st May, 2020.

Q. Who benefits?

- Persons mentioned in the earlier government order.
- This scheme has also been extended to accredited journalists who have Press Accreditation Cards issued by the Information and Cultural Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal.
